

Welcome to Lake Oswego Youth Football 2008

To all Returning and Future Laker Players and Families:

Registration will begin on April 1 for boys entering 3rd-8th grade in the fall 2008. All players must be registered in a school within the Lake Oswego High School boundaries to be eligible to play or live in Lake Oswego boundary and attend a private school elsewhere in the area. We will again be using online registration this year through our website www.lakerfootball.org. Our host, Bonzi, has upgraded the software this year to be more efficient. Every player will need to create a new account even if you used this system last year. There will be a credit card option online or you can pay by check at the Open House as well.

NEW:

We are bringing back the Open House April 16th 6-9pm and April 19th 9-12

All players need to bring their player contract and payment (if paying by check) to one of the open house times. All players will be weighed and measured. Location will be the building across the parking lot from the pool (same location as equipment hand-outs last year).

Fees for 2008- The fee is \$250 per player and an additional \$17 field usage fee. This includes a \$25 non-refundable administrative fee. After June 15th, a \$25 late fee will be added and the player will be put on a waiting list until we determine we have enough room. A limited amount of financial aid assistance is available.

Steve Coury Youth Football Camp registration will be available through Community School online, by phone, or in person and at the Open House. Fees are \$60 and hours count toward conditioning necessary before players can suit up.

LOYF Apparel will be available for purchase at the Open House in April, Equipment Hand-outs, and Jamboree. Cash or check only please.
